

OUTCOMES

PRIMARY OUTCOME

Term delivery (≥ 37 0/7 weeks gestation) with a normal cardiac rhythm

- Chosen because it is a binary outcome (yes/no) that is not amenable to bias
- Allowing the pregnancy to continue to term is a key clinical goal in SVA treatment
- Restoration of cardiac rhythm prior to birth is a key goal in SVA treatment, to allow interpretation of the fetal heart rate tracings for signs of distress during labor

SECONDARY OUTCOMES

Proportion of patients with cardioversion over time

Proportion of patients with treatment failure

Cross-over to

Cause of death (prenatal, postnatal)

Proportion of patients with arrhythmia related death

Average gestational age at birth

Birth weight (z-scores)

Average days of maternal and neonatal hospitalization related to therapy

Maternal prevalence of pregnancy/treatment-related AEs and outcomes

Proportion of AEs / adverse outcomes (prenatal, postnatal)
